The 2021 Global Neurosurgery Lyceum Series is accepting abstracts for the Global Neurosurgical Update & Educational Summit.

The submission deadline for abstracts is **October 4, 2021**. Notification of abstract status will be emailed by **October 11, 2021**.

General Guidelines

- Abstracts must be submitted and presented only in English.
- Individuals should submit material only if they, or a designee, are committed to registering for and attending the conference to present the paper or poster.
- There is a limit of two abstracts per person which can be submitted.
- There are two types of presentations: oral and e-poster presentation.
- You may indicate your presentation preference (oral or e-poster). The Abstract Selection Committee determines the final presentation format. If you're selected for an oral presentation, you will be required to submit a power point presentation, for which you will allotted 10 minutes time. If you're selected for an e-poster, you should submit a pdf (maximum 2 pages) of your article, which will displayed on our site during the symposium.
- Please specify on each abstract who is the presenting author, if your abstract contains multiple co-authors.
- Please specify which category your submitting the abstract under: Medical Student or Resident/Fellow or Others. Awards will only be given for the best abstract in the following categories: Medical Student and Resident/Fellow.
- Registration is not mandatory in the submission process. However, all presenters must register for the conference by **October 4, 2021**, otherwise the abstract will not be included in the final program.
- There will be no extension for abstract submission after **October 4, 2021**.
- All abstracts must have conclusion/results completed by the submission date. Abstracts describing data that have not yet been collected and/or analyzed as of the abstract deadline will be rejected.
- Abstracts may be edited until the deadline for submission. After that date, no changes in content or authors may be made. Edits would include changing the title, adding or deleting authors or changing the abstract body. Once the review process begins, no changes to the submissions are allowed; no exceptions.
- Abstracts must promote quality in healthcare or advances in science and must not promote a specific product or pharmaceutical, biotech and/or device company. In addition, abstracts selected for the symposium cannot contain advertising, trade names or a product-group message. Generic names or terms must be used in your abstract content.
- Certificates will be sent to the presenting author after the event (if any of the co-authors would like a certificate, then they must be registered for the event).
- Members of Industry: Your abstract content must be limited to basic science research (e.g., preclinical research, drug discovery) or the processes/methodologies of research, themselves unrelated to a specific disease or compound/drug. Content must not be related to clinical applications of the research/discovery or clinical recommendations concerning the business lines or products of your employer.
